Macmillan Caring Locally is a small, local charity based at Christchurch Hospital.

Our charity was registered in 1974 and works in partnership with University Hospitals Dorset NHS Foundation Trust, to provide an exceptional standard of care across South East Dorset and South West Hampshire.



We need to raise over £1.8 million per year to help fund the extensive services provided by our dedicated team. We rely on the generosity of our community to continue our vital work, helping us to support those who need our specialist care.

Although we share the Macmillan name, our charity, Macmillan Caring Locally is not connected to the national organisation Macmillan Cancer Support.

What we do

We provide specialist palliative care and support for people within our community who are affected by advanced and life-limiting illness, either at home or in our hospice, The Macmillan Unit.

We support sixteen in-patient beds at The Macmillan Unit, a Community Specialist Palliative Care Team, our Hospice at Home Team as well as a further team of Clinical

Nurse Specialists based at Royal Bournemouth Hospital.

Palliative care prevents and relieves suffering through the early identification, correct assessment and treatment of pain as well as other problems whether physical, psychosocial, or spiritual. We provide a dedicated Patient and Family Support Team, Rehabilitation Team, Complementary Therapy, Welfare Benefits Advice, and Chaplaincy Services.
